We are a not-for-profit public interest urban design center with a focus on Chattanooga's downtown.

About the Position

Part-time; runs May 16 to August 12, 2016. Three positions are available.

The Intern will assist Design Studio staff with professional design and planning projects located within Chattanooga's dynamic downtown and Innovation District. Current projects respond to challenges in the urban environment, and include asset mapping, community engagement, redevelopment proposals, and traffic and streetscape studies.

Qualifications

We are seeking a career-track college or graduate student who can contribute to professional-level project work. You should bring some knowledge or interest in one or more of the following: Chattanooga; urban design; the public realm; green infrastructure; and community development. We value a variety of skills, with an emphasis on design thinking and visual communication. You should be proficient in one or more of the following: 3D modelling; AutoCAD; Adobe suite, or GIS. You should be prepared to work in a team setting and to work independently under the direction of the permanent staff.

Duties and Compensation

Prepare studies and visual materials in support of the design process, prepare for and participate in community meetings; and survey and document field conditions and community preferences.

Compensation is \$10 per hour, 20 hours a week.
